DE prepared the 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 Annual MS4 Reports for the Parish's LPDES Permit as well as nine (9) existing SPCC Plans, thirteen (13) existing SWPPP Plans, and up to forty-two (42) new SPCC/SWPPP Plans.

DE's original contract was for a three year period but due to our continued responsiveness we have received two additional one year contract extensions through July 2020.

Specific Outcomes Achieved:

As program manager we make sure that all stormwater pollution prevention plans, spill control and response plans and annual reports are completed as per the Jefferson Parish LPDES MS4 Permit guidelines and that all reports and plans are submitted on time to remain in compliance with Jefferson Parish's LDEQ Stormwater Permit.
